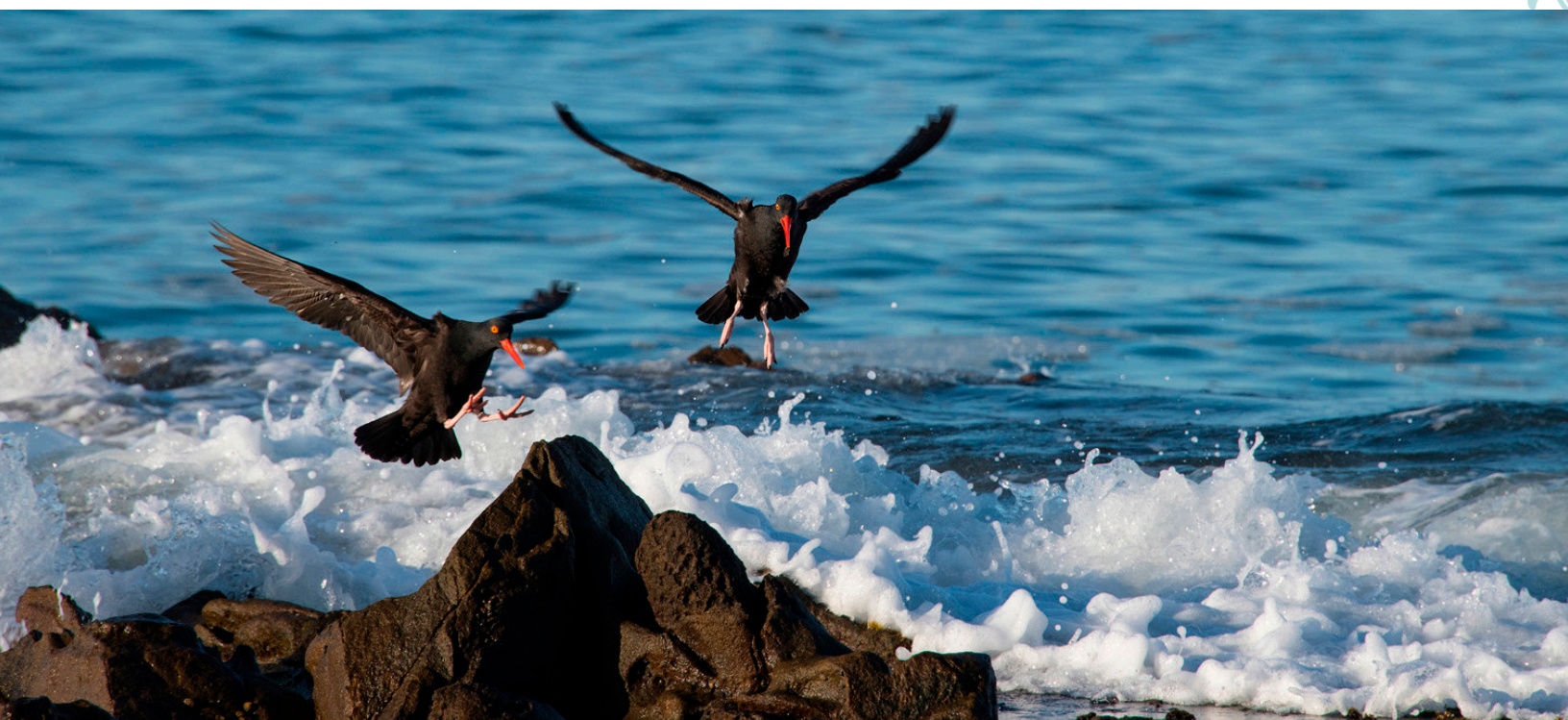


# ECOLOGY OF MARINE & ESTUARINE BIRDS
